Foul vs. No Foul

- How much contact?
- Trifling?



DFK/PK vs. IFK

- Kicks
- Trips
- Jumps at
- Charges
- Strikes
- Pushes
- Tackles
- Holds
- Spits at
- Handles the ball
- “6 seconds”
- “Double possession”
- “Pass back”
 - Foot
 - Throw in
- Dangerous play
- Impeding
- Prevents goalkeeper from releasing the ball
- Any other offense...play is stopped to issue YC or RC
 - e.g., **Simulation**



Yellow Card vs. Red Card

- Careless, Reckless, Excessive Force
- **Tackles**
 - Mode of Contact
 - Lunging
 - Studs exposed
 - Locked leg
 - Speed and force
 - Leaves feet
 - Area of Contact



Yellow Card vs. Red Card

- **Tactical Fouls**

- Designed to break up a promising attack
- Typically a minor nature
- Defender is beat

- **Elbows**

- Tool
 - Used to help
- Weapon
 - Used to destroy



Offside vs. No Offside

- Keys to Success
 - Position
 - Concentration
 - See the ball and the offside line
 - Be patient
 - Be 100% sure
